Pennyhooks Farm features in a half hour documentary called 'A Farm Like No Other' which is being screened at 7:30 pm on 16th February on BBC South East. It will also be available on BBC iPlayer.

It is part of a series of current affairs programmes on topics like farming, manufacturing, mental health and crime, filmed 'from the ground up'.

Organics, to film the students as they took their willow
wreaths and eggs to sell at the shops.
