#### West Vale Mobility - Volunteers needed

West Vale Mobility is a Wheelchair Accessible Vehicle Group serving (initially) Elm Tree Surgery patients living in Shrivenham, Watchfield, Longcot and Bourton. It aims to provide affordable, disability-friendly, sustainable, local transport, and has already been awarded a grant to cover the purchase and running costs of a vehicle for five years.

Users would pay a charge per mile, so approximately £3 to get to GWH. Not only will this help villagers it will help reduce the pressure on the NHS, too.

We need volunteers to be part of the managing committee as well as, of course, drivers. Can you help us get this exciting initiative off the ground?
