
#### World Day of Prayer

#### St Andrew's Bellringers' AGM



The Shrivenham ringers' AGM was held during their regular tower practice on Monday 10th March. Rev'd Patrick Mabhunu was invited to chair the meeting. He was barely though the door when he was handed a rope and, with the expert help of Tony Crabtree, joined the band for a short ring on the bells.

Reports on the past year's activities were presented by the Tower Captain, Steeple Keeper and Treasurer. The Tower accounts were approved and it was noted that various activities had raised £179.50 for the Church Restoration Fund and a further £416.45 had been transferred to the Church General Fund.

Patrick was presented with a framed certificate commemorating the Quarter Peal rung to celebrate his Induction as Vicar. He thanked the ringers for all they do to support the mission of the church.

#### **Bells in the Benefice**

All of the Benefice churches have bells. There are turret bells at Bourton (2), Fernham (1) and Watchfield (1), and a chiming bell at Compton Beauchamp.

The bells at Ashbury (6), Longcot (8) and Shrivenham (10) are hung for full-circle change ringing and have active bands of ringers. New recruits and returning ringers of all ages are always welcome, and we have experienced teachers to help you progress.
