


Messy Church is a church with a difference! A chance to be creative, hear Bible stories, eat yummy food and have fun with friends and family.

Open the Book

Open the Book (OtB) is an exciting storytelling project where Bible stories are shared with children in a way that is fun, interactive and memorable. As invited guests in school, storytelling teams use the Open the Book programme to prepare and present a 10–15-minute scripted Bible story to a school assembly, involving the children as much as possible.

The Bible Society is running a free Open the Book training session on from 10am to 1pm on Monday 17th November in Tower Lodge, Church Lane, Ashbury. This is for the team who will start OtB in Asbury School in January. However, others in the Benefice are welcome to come along, perhaps as a refresher if they've been part of a team before, or as a taster of what OtB is, with a view to starting a group in one of our other primary schools.
