#### **SERMON**

#### **WASHING OF FEET**

*Silence is kept.*

*The washing of feet may end with this prayer.*

Almighty Father,  
whose Son Jesus Christ taught us  
that what we do for the least of our brethren  
we do also for him:  
give us the will to be the servant of others  
as he was the servant of all,  
who gave up his life and died for us,  
yet is alive and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit,  
one God, now and for ever. **Amen.**

## INTERCESSIONS

*Silence may be kept and biddings used before each versicle and response.*

- After the 1<sup>st</sup> Intercession: Lord, hear us –  
**and humble us.**
- After the 2<sup>nd</sup> Intercession: Lord, hear us –  
**and unite us.**
- After the 3<sup>rd</sup> Intercession: Lord, hear us –  
**and renew our zeal.**
- After the 4<sup>th</sup> Intercession: Lord, hear us –  
**and fill us with your love.**
- After the 5<sup>th</sup> Intercession: Lord, hear us –  
**and give us your peace.**

**Most merciful Lord, your love compels us to come in. Our hands were unclean, our hearts were unprepared; we were not fit even to eat the crumbs from under your table. But you, Lord, are the God of our salvation, and share your bread with sinners. So cleanse and feed us with the precious body and blood of your Son, that he may live in us and we in him; and that we, with the whole company of Christ, may sit and eat in your kingdom. Amen.**

## EUCCHARISTIC PRAYER

### Eucharistic Prayer B [Manudy Thursday]

The Lord be with you  
*All* **and also with you.**

Lift up your hearts.

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.  
*All* **It is right to give thanks and praise.**

Father, we give you thanks and praise  
through your beloved Son Jesus Christ, your  
living..... for ever praising you and  
*saying:*

*All* **Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might,  
heaven and earth are full of your glory.  
Hosanna, Hosanna, Hosanna in the highest.**

**Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.

Lord, you are holy indeed, the source of all  
holiness;..... Do this, as often as you drink it,  
in remembrance of me.

## COMMUNION

### LORD'S PRAYER

heaven and we share the eternal banquet with Jesus Christ  
our Lord. Amen.**
