Face Coverings are Mandatory in Churches

There is an exemption for those who are officiating at services and presiding at Holy Communion, and those who assist them (for instance by reading, preaching, or leading prayers) who do not always need to wear a face covering, although one should be worn if physical distancing cannot be maintained (such as at the

distribution of Holy Communion).

In line with government advice, children under 11 and people with disabilities or certain health conditions are also exempt from wearing face coverings.

Please do not come into church if you think you may have symptoms of Covid 19.

Safeguarding Sunday 11th October

It cannot have been entirely coincidental that the latest report of the Independent Inquiry into Child Sexual Abuse was published in the week leading up to Safeguarding Sunday on 11th October.

This is the day on which we are reminded that "Safeguarding is everyone's responsibility" and that "our churches work every day of the year to ensure they are safe places for all." Sadly, sometimes, not hard enough and Archbishop Justin has reminded us that "to fail at safeguarding casts a profound stain across every good thing we do."
