We meet at 3pm on the second Sunday of the month in St Thomas Church in Watchfield and each session is followed by refreshments in the Village Hall.


The sessions are led by our clergy team, and we are looking for people to join our team of volunteers who help to set up and clear away, serve refreshments, and more importantly help the children with their activities.
